CEREBRUM will focus its field of study, in the same fields the European Union addresses in its operations:

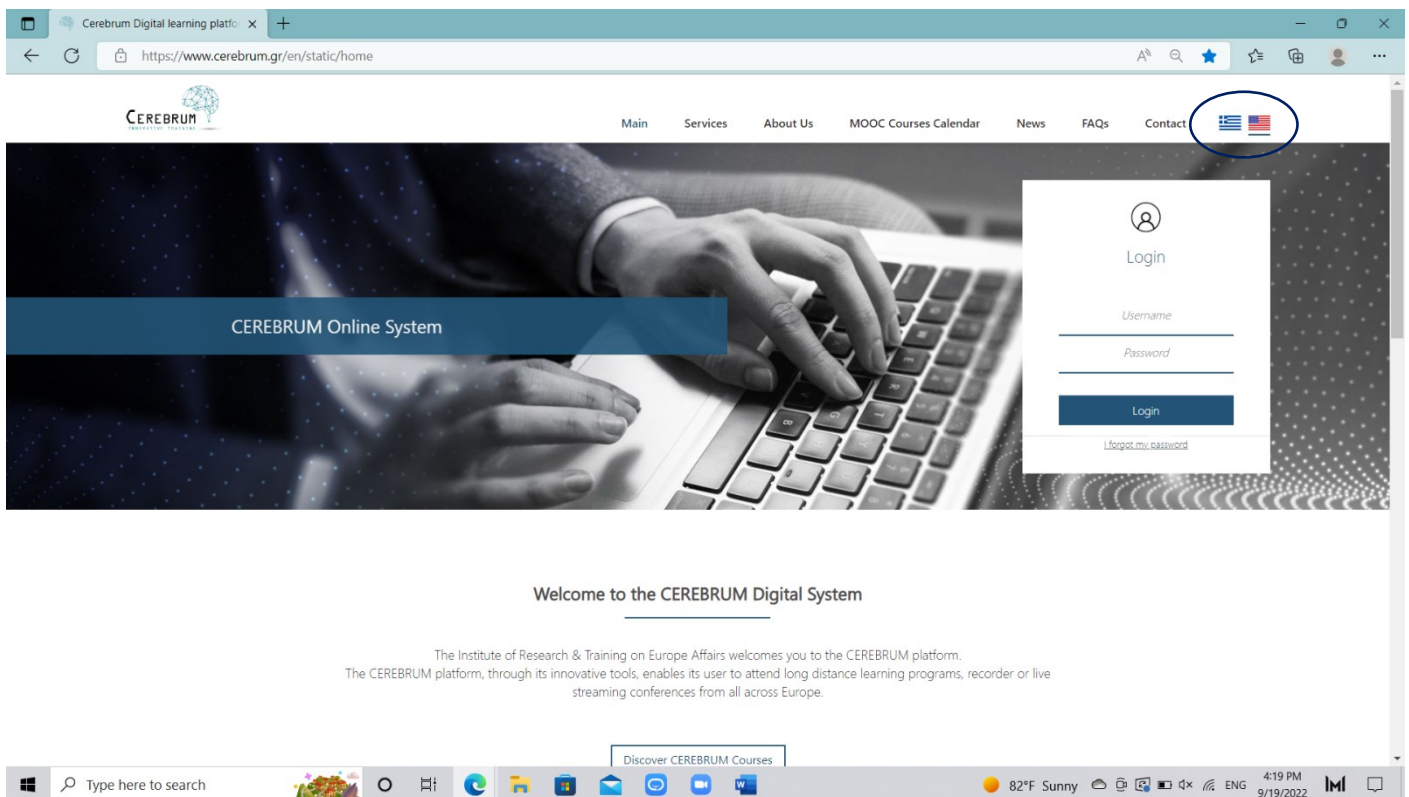
- Economic and Entrepreneurship Policies

How to Sign-up

In order to sign up to the CEREBRUM Platform you have to choose the course you want to attend at the MOOC Calendar and fill in the application form via there.

Step 1: Visit the www.cerebrum.gr which will lead you at the homepage. There you have the option of navigating in two languages, Greek and English. The alteration of language can be done through clicking the flag you wish on the top right corner of the home page.



Step 2: Click on the “MOOC Courses Calendar” to access all the available courses. There you have to choose and register the one you are interested in (*in our case “SMART Youth Centers”*). Click “Register” next to it.




After you login with your credentials you will find your homepage with the courses you have access to, and the learning experience can begin!

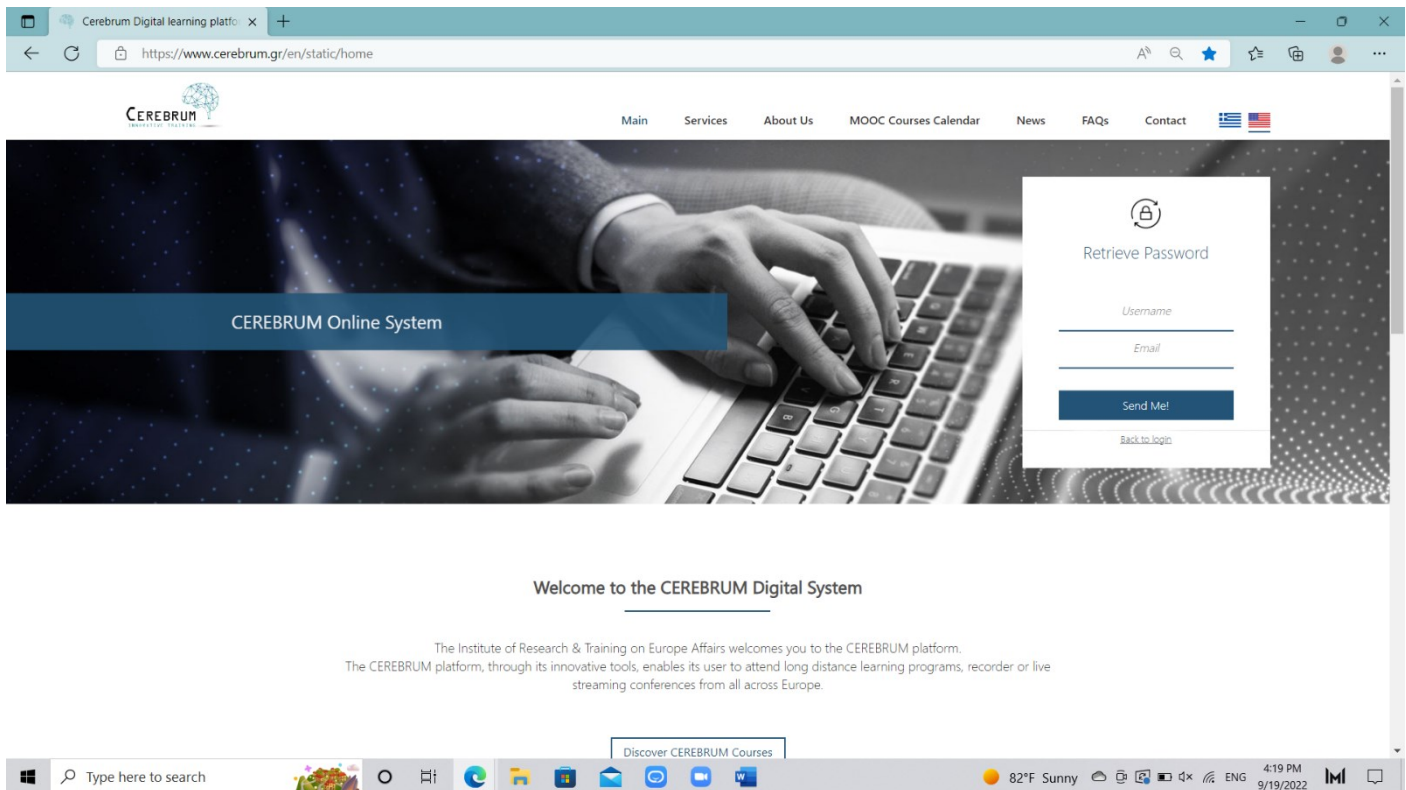
